1 An act to help preserve a country's economy through protection of its economic resources.

3 **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

5 Justification Clause: Many country's have economic and natural resources which they have developed a
6 reputation for in order support their economy. These resources of vitally important to the country's

16 long as a charter to protect the rights of all countries, and in particular the developing States, is not
17 formulated.

19 Section II: We would like for the UN Trade and Development Committee to look into our complaint and
20 research similar problems globally. After the fact finding mission is complete, we would like for the
21 committee to make a recommendation to the UN regarding ways to address the issue so that a country
22 cannot counterfeit and cause damage to the legitimate interest of another.
