1 A Proposal to place a new Government, run by the people, in a failing Country

3 **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

5 Justification Clause: More than 20% of countries are in a failing government situation. 50% of all countries
6 are on the verge of failing. These statistics clearly show the need for a proposal to put in place a government
7 system that is suited for the country's needs.

9 Section I: In the case of a failing country, the United Nations would send in 3 representatives under cover,
10 and investigate on what is causing the country to fail. After 6 months of investigation, the representatives
11 would evaluate the situation, and vote on the appropriate change of system of government. The vote has to
12 be at least 2/3 of the vote to agree. After the vote has taken place, the representatives will present the new
13 form of government to the people of the country, and the proposal of the government must be approved by
14 majority of the population. After voting, the representatives would stay under cover, and evaluate how the
15 new system of government is working. If the government system is unattainable and not fixing the
16 problem, the representatives will come together again and reevaluate the situation, the process will take way
17 again.

19 Section II: Haiti has more than 80% of its population under the poverty line, 70% of the population does not
20 have direct access to clean water, and only 1% of the population controls the wealth. At the moment Haiti is
21 a semi- Republic country, but with all the problems occurring the government system is not taking part, and
22 enforcing solutions. Therefore this is a horrible situation in which citizens are being harmed and a new
23 government needs to be put in place to fix all of these events.

25 Section III: This proposal would solve multiple problems occurring in countries like Haiti, such as poverty,
26 control issues, hunger, etc. With changing the government there will we a more stable country that will have
27 stability to change the ideals of that country, and embrace the problems, in order to fix.

29 Section IV: The United Nations will play a role in this situation by selecting the 3 representatives that will
30 investigate, from their team of officials. As well as being the group who oversees all the countries searching
31 for the one in need of assistance.

33 Section V: Expenses will come in the flights, and stay of the representatives, which would total up to about
34 30,000 per person for the yearly process. The funding will be given by a DFATD, a Canadian global funding
35 program, as well as any extra funders willing to donate to cause.

37 Section VI: This proposal will go into effect in September 1st, 2015
