4 5	Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations
5 6 7 8 9 10 11	Justification Clause: Globally, many nations have been experiencing economic crises. The small nation of Montenegro has been hit particularly hard, with unemployment reaching record levels. With a current unemployment level at close to 15%, Montenegrin citizens, particularly the young adults, need resources to provide education and job opportunities. The passage of this proposal would allow for Montenegro to begin reducing and eliminating this issue.
12 13 14 15 16	Section I: The UN will appoint a task force, consisting of UN appointees and Montenegrin citizens, to investigate the problem of high unemployment in Montenegro, create a plan to educate the citizens of Montenegro in employable skills, and utilize the natural resources of Montenegro to provide more job opportunities.
17 18 19 20 21 22	Section II: The task force will consist of 15 members, including a mix of UN appointees and Montenegrin citizens. The UN appointees should be experts in the fields of development and education. The Montenegrin citizens will include at least one representative of the general public, at least one representative from the Montenegro Ministry of Education, and at least one representative from the Montenegro Ministry of Labor and Social Welfare. Representatives from a variety of regions in Montenegro are also encouraged.
22 23 24 25 26 27	Section III: A particular area of focus for the task force will be a plan for the development of regional training centers for the citizens. These centers should be designed to provide food and shelter for citizens as they do job training. Job centers should also focus on training citizens to become trainers so that the UN representatives only do the initial training.
28 29 30	Section IV: The task force will create a plan to utilize the natural resources in Montenegro to increase job opportunities. Areas of focus will include Tourism, Port Resources, and Agriculture.
31 32	Section V: The task force will develop a plan to attract foreign investors to build industry in Montenegro.
33 34 35	Section VI: The task force should be prepared to present a viable plan of action within 24 months of the installation of the task force.
36	Section VII: This proposal will go into effect 90 days after passage.
