A proposal for the United Nations to create an international bill of rights.

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: This proposal would allow people to have the same rights as other people regardless of their beliefs, physical and mental abilities, sexual orientation, race, and gender.

Section I: Example of rights included would be right to speech, religion, press, and expression.

Section II: For example: in Peru homosexual men and women do not have the same rights and are beaten to death if they try to protest. Some have been shot by police because of protests. Their rights are also very different than other citizens. They cannot say what they want or they will be shot. They cannot be in school. If they have any disability's and they are homosexual, they will be assigned a guardian to watch over them; the guardians usually neglect them.

Section III: This proposal will give all humans in all nations the same basic human rights regardless of race, gender, or sexual orientation.

Section IV: This proposal does not require funding.

Section V: This bill proposal will go into effect in 2015–2016
