1                    An Act to Monitor and Investigate South Korea Freedom of Speech Cases and Rights

3                    **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

5    Justification Clause: Freedom of speech is a right in the constitution of South Korea (article 21). However,  
6    there have been many cases where freedom of speech has been violated. Bloggers have gotten arrested,  
7    freedom of press has limitations, some political/ social content is blocked, and censorship has been taking  
8    place. Since 2008 freedom of speech rights have been demolishing at a scary rate.

10   Section I: If a citizen's freedom of speech is violated a team of United Nations officials will investigate the  
11   case. If it is proven that the citizen's rights have been violated the government will be fined a predetermined  
12   amount by the United Nations.

14   Section II: This proposal will ensure citizens are getting the right of freedom of speech as stated in the  
15   constitution.

17   Section III: This proposal will be beneficial world wide and will have a rippling impact. This system starts in  
18   South Korea and could eventually spread to other countries world wide. It will also allow other countries to  
19   remain informed about what is going on in South Korea.

21   Section IV: This proposal will go into effect January 1, 2015.
