1 An act to request a group of UN peace-keepers to train the current police force.

3 **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

5 Justification Clause: The Turkmenistan 2012 Human Rights Report states: "Security officials tortured and
6 beat criminal suspects, prisoners and individuals deemed critical of the government to extract confessions
7 and as a form of punishment... Methods of torture employed by the security officials included `the
8 administration of electric shocks; asphyxiation applied with a plastic bag or forcible wearing of a gas mask to
9 which the air supply is cut; forcibly administering psychotropic drugs; beating with batons, truncheons, or
10 plastic bottles filled with water; punching; kicking; depriving of food and drink; and exposing prisoners to
11 extreme cold while removing warm clothes."

13 Section I: The goal is to get the police forces from Turkmenistan to uphold the integrity of the constitution.
14 The UN peace-keepers will come in and retrain the police forces to do their job in which they uphold the local
15 constitution. The UN will be asked to send in 350 peace-keepers to make sure the law is being upheld. The
16 Turkmen will feel safe and more comfortable in their own country. This may also influence other countries in
17 this region to take a step and help their country become a better place.

19 Section II: The peace-keepers that will go to Turkmenistan will go with a definite goal to train the new police
20 force and retrain the old police force. They will seek to make sure that the Constitution is being upheld in the
21 entire country.

23 Section III: The Turkmenistan government does not release official statistics, but based off of first hand
24 witnesses the crime rate is about average compared to the countries immediately around them. The peace-
25 keepers have a goal to lower this where witnesses would be able to say Turkmenistan has much less crime
26 than the countries immediately around them by having the police force uphold the laws.

27
28 Section IV: The security council of the United Nations will oversee this operation.

29
30 Section V: The General Assembly will pay for 27.1% of the cost for the peace-keepers. The rest will be paid
31 by raising the taxes in Turkmenistan by 2%.

33 Section VI: This will go into effect on January 1st, 2017, and the training will start as soon as this proposal
34 is passed.
