An act to allow imports of paper product and lumber in Argentina

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Currently no imports over 10 pounds or worth more than \$3000 are allowed to be imported into Argentina. This has caused a loss of 105 million hectares (1hectare=1000 meters) of forest due to the constant need of lumber and farming space. We propose if paper products and lumber are allowed to be imported to help restore the forest.

Section I: To reduce the deforestation in Argentina, we propose the act of lifting the ban on all paper products and lumber being imported into the country. Large manufacturers will have this as an option, instead of using lumber by cutting down the forests within the country.

Section II: Because Argentina will now need lumber to be imported from other places, it will benefit other countries that have lumber as a main export. China, Brazil, and the United States were major trade partners up until the ban of large imports in Argentina.

Section III: This proposal will benefit many people. It could potentially bring in jobs for the people of Argentina. It will cost virtually zero money to the government and will require no funding from the government. This will only increase the profits of the Argentines.

Section IV: This proposal will go into effect immediately upon passage.
