1                   An act to install rain water harvestation in major countries across the world.

3                   **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

5   Justification Clause: In Bolivia and other major countries such as Nigeria, Central and South America, Central  
6   Africa, India, and South East Asia citizens have lack of clean water which leads to diseases and illness that  
7   can become life threatening. Many water systems in poor countries would not exist but for the private  
8   funding mandated by international lending institutions. Cash strapped governments simply had no choice but  
9   to outsource expensive up-front costs of providing water to their citizens. Governments overwhelmed by  
10   development needs are often unable to efficiently manage the complexity of water extraction, treatment,  
11   delivery, and finance.

13   Section I: According to the United Nations, water is polluted by dirt, sand, and erosion. Dirty water kills  
14   5,000 children a day. The major cause of children's illness or death is dirty water.

16   Section II: The United Nations will donate 1 million dollars to get the technology and equipment to place rain  
17   water harvestation in major countries in extreme lack of water. The equipment for this bill for each building  
18   would be about \$4,000 this goes toward all the equipment and people to install this equipment.

20   Section III: This proposal will go into effect January 2015.
