1                                   An act to solve the water crises in Cambodia and around the world.

3                                   **Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations**

5   Justification Clause: Cambodia has the second lowest rate of clean water supply in Southeast Asia. This  
6   leads to disease, environmental problems, and hinders economic development. The largest problem that  
7   arises from poor water quality is diarrhea. Diarrhea kills more children under the age of five than malaria,  
8   tuberculosis, and HIV combined. For every dollar invested on improving water sanitation in the world, \$7 is  
9   gained in economic benefit.

11   Section I: Health & Hygiene Education: Counselors will be assigned by UN-Water, the United Nations inter-  
12   agency coordination mechanism for all freshwater and sanitation related matters, to travel and teach about  
13   basic health and hygiene in rural areas.

15   Section II: Solar-Powered Water Pumps: UN-Water will work to install solar-powered water pumps that will  
16   provide 30,000 liters of clean water each day. The cost of each pump is approximately \$200 and can  
17   service up to a 200 square kilometer area.

19   Section III: Funding will come from the current 31 UN-Water Member Programmes.

21   Section IV: This proposal will go into effect 90 days upon passage to ensure time for the counselors to be  
22   assigned and pumps secured.
