An act to increase the access to clean water in India.

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: 93.3 million people in India do not have access to clean, drinkable water. This proposal would provide educators to explain why polluted water is bad for you, and what we can do to fix it. This would also provide water filtration systems to cleanse the water and make it drinkable, and enable it for cooking and cleaning. This would prevent the rising number of deaths due to bad water from taking more lives. Our goal is to increase the number of healthy water systems in India.

Section I: The United Nations will provide educators to the people of India to issue knowledge on why clean water is beneficial, and what the polluted water can do to you. This will make the citizens of India realize the detriment they are doing to themselves and their bodies by drinking this polluted water.

Section II: The United Nations will work hand in hand in hand with Project Humanity to produce Ultra Violet Filtration Systems to the cities and rural areas of India. These will purify water for things like drinking and cooking. Project Humanity and the UN will work together to make accessible clean water with these Filtration Systems.

Section III: If the area refuses the Filtration System the people will be fined 20% of the cost of the Water Filtration System.

Section IV: This proposal will go into effect 90 days upon passage, and will apply to all cities and rural areas that do not have a healthy water system.
