An act to reduce water pollution in Ireland and surrounding countries

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Water is one of the most important necessities in life. England has a leaky nuclear plant that needs to be shut down and contained. Since the pollution is in the water, it will spread to other countries, including Ireland. Ireland also has issues with trash disposal and lack of recycling. The increased pollution is causing environmental decline and must be stopped.

Section I: The United Nations will oversee that the closure of the nuclear power plant in England is down in a timely and efficient manner.

Section II: England will be fined if they refuse to cooperate and will be in charge of all cleanup charges.

Section III: A recycling system will also be put into place in Ireland to help control the amount of trash and pollution in landfills as well as roadsides.

Section IV: The system will be paid for by charging citizens and businesses for the amount of garbage that they put out on a per-trash-can basis. As they begin to recycle, their trash will lessen.

Section V: This proposal will go into effect 90 days after its ratification.
