1 7	An act to improve living conditions in refugee camps by reducing the widespread damage caused by fire
2 3 4	Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations
5 6 7 8 9	Justification Clause: Currently there are 42 million displaced persons in the world. Many of these individuals are living in refugee camps and face overcrowding, poor hygiene, disease and violence every day. One of the greatest fears in these communities of refugees and idp's is the threat of fire. Fire quickly and completely consumes everything in its path and its effects are devastating.
10 11 12	Section I: United Nations personnel will go into Kenya to determine which refugee camps have the worst histories of fire or are in most immediate threat of fire.
13 14 15 16	Section II: These designated camps will be provided with supplies of fire retardant fabric and liquids. Both will be made available at food distribution centers within the camps. At the centers, camp residents will receive the amount of fabric and liquid necessary to protect their living quarters.
17 18 19	Section III: The fabric can be used to cover the walls and roof of individual structures. The liquid can be applied with spray equipment. Instruction will be provided on the effective use of the products.
20 21 22	Section IV: In time, the program will spread to other countries and other continents. It will be funded by the United Nations High Commission on Refugees (UNHCR).
23	Section V: This proposal will take effect immediately upon passage.
