An act to allow foreign citizens to get a place to call home without having citizenship

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: Due to the foreseen rise of ocean levels over the next several decades, this act will allow people who are displaced due to global climate change a place to live.

Section I: This proposal will allow foreign citizens to move to a country using a ship provided by the United Nations. They will also have an opportunity to get a job so they can set to buy a home for themselves or their family. This will be useful because it will allow them to settle in until they get citizenship in that country. This way they can still support their families. Most countries say that you need to live there for 10 years before being granted citizenship.

Section II: This proposal will cost \$100 per person. The money will be provided by the United Nations. The money will be used for buying fuel for the ship and also essential supplies.
