20 21 22	Section III: CLAR will offer loans and technological support to member nations with approved projects. These member nations would then be required to pay back the loans upon completion of their reclamation projects.

26 27 28	Section V: The loans would be provided by the World Bank at an interest rate determined by the CLAR, based on the country's ability to repay.
