An act to make health care affordable and available to all classes of citizens within Peru.

Be it hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the United Nations

Justification Clause: One third of the Peruvian population lacks basic health care services. Though a number of reforms have been implemented in the previous years, the problem has yet to be resolved. Local governments scramble to inform their citizens of their entitled benefits. Poverty stricken citizens who are informed struggle to complete the convoluted paperwork necessary to receive benefits. The current system isn't working; every citizen should have access to equitable healthcare.

Section I: A taskforce of healthcare individuals will determine how healthcare funds will be allocated. These individuals will also ensure that all money is used appropriately.
