Justification Clause: During December 2013, South Sudan began the world's newest civil war. With disputes between the rebels and government no one paid attention to the needs of the people. Although the government started the fight, the people are receiving the consequences. Both the rebels and government unleashed powerful military weapons killing more than 500 civilians in just a few days. The UN is providing help, but not enough to meet the essential needs of the innocent victims. Housing more than 34,000 civilians in two UN bases with limited medical care and security creates an unstable environment for the people of South Sudan who are seeking refuge.

Section I: The United Nations will continue to provide food, water, and other basic essentials to the civilians of South Sudan.

Section II: UN shelters housing civil war refugees should be expanded by size or increased in number to ensure no shelter exceeds the maximum amount of civilians while still providing shelter for everyone who requires it.

Section III: The United Nations will continue to provide medical provisions for the South Sudan refugees. For future health benefits, the United Nations will supply health education to the general public, such as, sanitary wound care, personal health management, nutrition, and child care.

Section IV: The United Nations will continue to provide military, civilian police, and international civilian personnel to South Sudan. Equal distribution of personnel will be required in order to protect each UN base properly for the safety of staff and civilians.
