1 An act to prohibit adults from smoking in the car if there are children inside the car with
2 them

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4 Section 1: It has been proven that second hand smoke is very harmful to those who inhale
5 it. Furthermore, it has been proven that smoke exposure in a car is 23 times worse
6 than smoke in a public place such as a restaurant. Approximately 40,000 people die
7 every year due to the effects of second hand smoke.

9 Section 2: This bill will effect smokers who have children under the age of 18 in their car.
10 Adults may not smoke in their car if there are children under the age of 18 inside
11 the car with them.

13 Section 3: Police will enforce this bill. Consequences for breaking this law would be:
14 First offense: \$100.00
15 Second offense: \$200.00
16 Third offense: \$300.00
17 Fourth offense: Suspension of driver’s license for thirty (30) days

19 Section 4: This bill will take effect January 1, 2015.
