1	An act to illegalize tobacco use of people under the age of 18
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: Kentucky is the main provider of tobacco in the United States, with this title comes the challenges
6	of underage tobacco use. Tobacco use under the age of 18 is not punishable by law in the state of
7	Kentucky; but selling tobacco to a minor or giving tobacco to a minor is considered a crime in the state on
8	Kentucky.
9	
10	Section 2: 119,000 people will die yearly in Kentucky due to smoking that started as a child. This bill would
11	make use of tobacco underage illegal, with the same punishments as underage drinking which is, if eligible
12	for a drivers license a 30 day to 6 month suspension, a \$100 to \$500 dollar fine. If the minor or the family
13	cannot pay the fine they will have to do 20 hours of community service.
14	
15	Section 3: 50% of the money made from fines will go to the Kentucky state government, and the other 50%
16	will go to research for lung cancer.
17	
18	Section 4: This bill would allow a police officer to stop a minor that is using or in possession of tobacco, and
19	take him/her into custody.
20	
21	Section 5: If this bill is passed, it will go into effect January 1st 2015.
