5	Section 1: In the state of Kentucky, construction projects take over roads by the immense amount going on			
6	at one time. We would like to limit the amount of construction projects going on at one time to a maximu			
7	of 3.

9	Section 2: The purpose of this bill is to regulate traffic, help local businesses, and reduce the costs for			
10	citizens. The average amount of time it takes to finish a construction project is 35 months. The average			
11	construction project costs \$84,000. Reducing the amount of projects will decrease traffic and costs for			
12	citizens in the city.
