- 1 An act to promote Arts & Humanities education throughout all Kentucky schools.
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- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: Evaluations will conducted by the Kentucky Department of Education. Depending on evaluation
- 6 results, schools will be placed into one of multiple groups.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: Each Kentucky school will get a set amount of funding based in the category they were placed in.
- 9 They will receive the funds for 3 years. Then the Kentucky Department of Education will conduct another
- 10 evaluation to assess progress of the programs implemented by each school.

- 12 Section 3: A certain amount of funding will be set aside for Arts & Humanities education from lottery funds
- 13 already supplied for education.
- 14
- 15 Section 4: Schools that do not use funding appropriately will receive yearly evaluations from the Department
- 16 of Education until their programs rise to expectations.
- 17
- 18 Section 5: This bill be taken into affect in the 2015-2016 school years.
