ı	An act to Eliminate Smoking in All Enclosed Workplaces.

4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5	
6	Section 1: This bill would prohibit smoking and other tobacco product use at any enclosed workplace. It
7	would punish those who do not comply with this bill with fines.
8	
9	Section 2: The first offense will result in a warning to the business and the smoker. The second offense will
10	result in a \$250 fine to the business. If this fine goes unpaid, or if there is another offense, it will result in an
11	additional charge of \$1000.
12	
13	Section 3: This bill will require all workplaces to post no smoking signs in both English and Spanish, and to
14	have a designated smoking area at least 25 feet from all entrances and exits.
15	
16	Section 4: This bill will be enforced by employers and the police. It will be enforced in the entirety of the
17	Commonwealth.
18	

Section 5: This bill will go into effect on January 1st 2015.
