1 An act to mandate ACT testing in the freshmen and sophomore years.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: The ACT will be given one day per year in the freshmen and sophomore years of high school to
6 improve student familiarity with the test and testing conditions.

7
8 Section 2: The annual ACT test will be free of charge to students.

9
10 Section 3: The ACT test scores from the freshmen and sophomore years will not count in the school's
11 accountability index.

12
13 Section 4: Costs for this measure will be provided by a tax on cigarettes, not to exceed 2%.

14
15 Section 5: This bill will take effect in the 2015-2016 school year.
