1 An act to abolish all state income tax and increase sales tax over a five year time period.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: The average income tax of a Kentuckian is \$2,360 per year (2014). This Law would decrease the

6 income tax by \$590 per year and increase sales tax by 0.01% per year concluding with a final state sales tax

7 0.10%.

9 Section 2: Would begin January 1st, 2015 income tax would reduce and would no longer be in existence as

10 of the end of tax season in 2019.

12 Section 3: Sales tax would increase on January 1st on 2015 thru January 1st, 2019 and all increasing of

13 sales tax would conclude.
