1 An act to nullify the USA PATRIOT Act in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: The PATRIOT Act is a blatant violation of the 4th amendment of the Constitution. It gives
6 government authorities the ability to perform warrantless searches of citizens' computers, phones, financial
7 records, and even of their homes. Since the United States Congress and the Supreme Court have repeatedly
8 failed to recognize the unconstitutionality of the PATRIOT Act, it is time that the Commonwealth of Kentucky
9 takes matters into its own hands.

11 Section 2: On the first day of January in the year of 2015, the PATRIOT Act shall be null and void in the
12 Commonwealth of Kentucky.

14 Section 3: Federal Agents will no longer be allowed to use provisions of the PATRIOT Act to apprehend
15 citizens in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Searches and wiretaps performed without legitimate warrants
16 will be considered unlawful, and federal agents who participate in these unlawful acts will have criminal
17 charges brought up against them.
