1                   An act to impose drug testing on women during their second term of pregnancy.  
2  
3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4  
5   Section 1: Drug tests will be administered by the physician of the expected mother. Drugs will be tested  
6   during routine blood tests performed during the second trimester of pregnancy.  
7  
8   Section 2: If illicit addictive drugs are found in the woman's system within the second trimester by the  
9   physician, the woman will be sentenced to spend the remaining months of her pregnancy at a minimal  
10   security prison serving as a rehabilitation center. Within the center, the woman will receive medical attention  
11   to assist them in detoxing and monitor the fetus's health.  
12  
13   Section 3: If the fetus is born with drugs in its system, the proper medical attention will be provided to it.  
14  
15   Section 4: The mother loses custody of the child if the baby is born with drugs in his or her system due to  
16   negligent parenting. If the child is not born with drugs in his or her system due to detox, she will retain  
17   custody.  
18  
19   Section 5: If the mother retains custody of the child she will be subject to random drug tests performed by  
20   her parole officer, which will be assigned to her after the birth of the baby.  
21  
22   Section 6: If the baby is found with drugs in his or her system, the mother will stand trial under the charges  
23   of child abuse according to Ky. Rev. Stat. Ann article 600.020(1)(c) and appropriate sentencing will follow in  
24   accordance with that law.
