3 4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonweal	th of Kentucky		
5	Section 1: Currently there are nine centers in Kentucky that offer housing for	homeless veterans. However	,	
6	the amount of people they can accommodate is very limited. Increasing grants given to these institutions will			
7	decrease the amount of homeless veterans as well as assist them in adjustin	g to everyday life. The grants		
8	are not limited to merely increasing accommodation space. They can be used	to create programs within th	ie	
9	facility that assist veterans in struggles such as education, employment, sub-	stance abuse, mental health		
10	problems and more.			

Section 2: The term "veterans" refers to all Kentucky veterans who have completed their services.

Section 3: \$2 million for grants will be given to these institutions all together. The necessary funds for this bill will come from a portion of the sales tax.

Section 4: These grants will be monitored by the Kentucky Department of Veteran Affairs (KDVA) since it falls under their jurisdiction. Any institution found misusing grants will be subject to immediate suspension of funds as well as an investigation. The veterans will be taken to a different facility.

Section 5: This bill will be enacted immediately after it is passed.
