1	An act to prevent abuse of the elderly
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: Elder abuse is defined as intentional actions that cause harm or create a serious risk of
6	(regardless of whether harm was intended) to a vulnerable elder by a caregiver or other person who stands
7	in a trust relationship to the elderly person. This includes neglect, physical abuse, emotional abuse, sexual
8	abuse, and financial exploitation.
9	
10	Section 2: Under this bill, an elderly person shall be defined as any person who is at least 65 years of age.
11	
12	Section 3: An Elder Abuse Registry (EAR) shall be created and maintained by the Kentucky Department for
13	Public Health.
14	
15	Section 4: Any Person charged with any form of elder abuse will automatically have their criminal charge
16	raised one degree if the crime is not already in the first degree.
17	
18	Section 5: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2015
