1	An act to A bill to require animals to be restrained in vehicles.
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: The safety of drivers and pets are at risk when the pet is an unrestrained passenger.
6	Pets can be distracting to the driver and can become a dangerous projectile in the event of a crash.
7	Castion 2. When viding as a necessary in a webiele all note must be vestrained for the safety of the driver
8 9	Section 2: When riding as a passenger in a wehicle all pets must be restrained for the safety of the driver and the animal.
10	
11	Section 3: A restraint in the context of this bill is a kennel secured to the vehicle or a harness specifically
12	designed for the animal for use in a vehicle.
13	
14	Section 4: Funding received from taxes by the state will be used to inform the general public that this new bill
15	is going into effect.
16	
17	Section 5: Fines collected by violations of this bill will range between \$250-1000 depending on the severity
18	of the offense. The money raised in this way will go towards state programs supporting animal rights such
19	as the Kentucky Humane Society.
20	
21	Section 6: This bill will go into effect six months following the date it is passed.
