1 An act to create Blood Donation Bonuses: a new subcategory of KEES funds for high school students.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: Students enrolled in any high school in the Commonwealth will be encouraged to donate blood
6 through the American Red Cross for the incentive of Blood Donation Bonuses added to their KEES funds.
7
8 Section 2: The Red Cross requires that students be at least sixteen (16) years old (with parent’s permission),
9 or seventeen (17) years or older (without parent’s permission), to donate blood.
10
11 Section 3: For each time a student donates blood, fifty (50) dollars will be added to their bi-annual, and
12 renewable, KEES funds.

14 Section 4: In order to receive credit, students will receive a new fifty (50) dollar voucher code to add to their
15 KEES Blood Donation Bonuses log at www.kheaa.com each time they donate.
16
17 Section 5: Students will be able to claim no more than four (4) separate blood donations. Therefore, students
18 will not be able to earn any more than two-hundred (200) dollars from Blood Donation Bonuses their four (4)
19 years in high school.

21 Section 6: Students must wait 8 weeks between blood donations. These and other safe blood donation
22 guidelines can be found at www.redcrossblood.org.

24 Section 7: Funding will be derived from KEES money and the Commonwealth Health Cabinet. In addition, any
25 voluntary support from the Red Cross—financial or otherwise—will be accepted.

27 Section 8: This bill will go into effect on August 1, 2015.
