- 1 An act to mandate all Kentucky Primary elections be changed from a closed system to a semi-closed system.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: Before an individual is allowed to vote in a primary election, he or she must possess all the
- 6 qualifications required to vote in an election.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: The voting individual must be either a registered member of the party he or she wants to vote for
- 9 or a registered independent who shall only vote in the primary of one party.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: Any registered voter, either registered as a member of a specific party or independent, is qualified
- 12 to vote in the primary elections for all candidates in non-partisan elections.
- 13
- 14 Section 4: Any person eligible to vote in a primary election is also eligible to vote in a future runoff primary if
- 15 one is needed.
