1	An act to construct a bullet train system in Kentucky
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: Due to a crumbling infrastructure of our current highways and bridges, a bullet train system will be
6	constructed in Kentucky in conjunction with the following states of Ohio, Indiana, and Illinois.
7	
8	Section 2: The creation of a bullet train system in Kentucky would be instrumental to the growth and
9	development of the state's economy by supplementing the state's existing infrastructure. This will allow
10	easier commutes to places of employment and bring different communities closer together.
