1	An act to extend Kentucky's DUI lookback period
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: This act amends KRS 189A.010 and extends Kentucky's DUI/DWI lookback period from five years
6	to eight years.
7	
8	Section 2: A lookback period is a legal expression that refers to the length of time that a previous offense
9	remains on a driver's record and can be used to add penalties if a new DUI/DWI offense is committed (also
10	known as a "washout").
11	
12	Section 3: A lookback period is commonly used in DUI/DWI laws to identify repeat offenders and amplify the
13	consequences to hopefully reduce recidivism. Recidivism is a tendency to relapse into a previous condition or
14	mode of behavior. According to state law, driving under the influence (DUI) , driving while intoxicated (DWI),
15	drunken driving, drunk driving, operating under the influence, drinking and driving, or impaired driving is the
16	crime of driving a motor vehicle while impaired by alcohol or other drugs including those prescribed by
17	physicians.

19 Section 4: This act will take effect July 1, 2015.
