- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: The state of Kentucky shall allow all parties to vote in an open primary in the state of Kentucky.
- 6
- 7 Section 2: When a party has no candidate in the general election, that party member may vote in the primary
- 8 election.
- 9
- 10 Section 3: When the primary election will decide the outcome of the general election, there being no other
- 11 party opposition for the general election, voters may vote in the primary.
