1 An act to to require regulations restricting Electronic Cigarette usage.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: As it stands, Electronic Cigarettes (henceforth eCigs, in reference to the physical devices) go
6 unregulated. This bill will change the current legislation in order to regulate eCigs and their usage in the
7 Commonwealth of Kentucky.

8
9 Section 2: : Minors (individuals under the age of eighteen (18)) will not be able to buy eCigs. This applies to
10 pre-owned units. Vendors will not be able to sell eCigs to minors. eCigs will not be allowed in any public
11 environment, unless otherwise specified. Smoking regulatory signs will be applicable to eCig usage.

13 Section 3: The consequences of eCig usage by minors will be outline by a three strike system.

14 Strike 1 : Warning, and Revocation of Device.

15 Strike 2 : Revocation of Device, a one-hundred dollar fine, and a discussion with Parents/Guardians of the
16 minor and Police Officers.

17 Strike 3 : Revocation of Device, a Court Date, a \$500 dollar fine, potential time in juvenile detention, and a
18 temporary revocation of any Driving Rights (i.e. Driver's Permit or Intermediate License.)

19 Vendors caught selling eCigs to minors will be fined \$200 dollars per unit sold.

21 Section 4: This will be enforced by any individual authorized to do so in the Commonwealth of Kentucky (i.e.
22 City Police, County Sheriff, State Police, U.S. Marshall, et c.)

24 Section 5: : This will be funded by a 15% (fifteen percent) excise tax on ALL eCig products, and all fines
25 collected by the state as a result of Section 3.

27 Section 6: This bill will go into effect on the July 1st after passage by the Assembly.
