- 1                                    An act to discard page 7, section 7 of Kentucky's Redbook regulations.

- 3                                    **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5    Section 1: Currently page 7, section 7 of the accounting procedures for Kentucky School Activity Funds,
- 6    "Redbook" states: "Fundraising proceeds must benefit the entire group, regardless of participation in the
- 7    fundraising activity. There will be no fundraisers taken by individual students."
- 8
- 9    Section 2: Our bill is to discard section 7 to allow fundraisers to be based upon what the individual sells
- 10   (profit) rather than the entire group.
- 11
- 12   Section 3: The Kentucky Department of Education will enforce this law by discarding Section 7 and allowing
- 13   individuals to receive individual fundraising profit.
- 14
- 15   Section 4: This bill requires no funding.
- 16
- 17   Section 5: This bill will be enacted on July 1, 2015 in preparation for the 2015-2016 school year.
