- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

- 5 Section 1: The purpose of this bill is to create a common grading scale in order for every student to have an
- 6 equal opportunity for success.

- 8 Section 2: This bill requires no additional funding being as a ten point grading scale is being established.
- 9
- 10 Section 3: The Kentucky Department of Education will be responsible for ensuring school districts are
- 11 educated on the ten point grading scale and all districts have implemented the scale.

- 13 Section 4: If a school district is found not to be following the ten point grading scale, District funds will be
- 14 cut.

- 16 Section 5: This bill will go into effect at the beginning of the 2015-2016 school year.
