1 An act to establish nuclear power plants in the commonwealth of Kentucky

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: This bill will be aimed towards providing Kentuckians with a clean, cheap and reliable energy
6 source that will not only provided the state with greater resources but also limit the amount of pollution in
7 the environment.

9 Section 2: In a 2008 study, it was found the less than 400 nuclear power plants attributed to over 13% of
10 the world’s energy supply and the nuclear power plants in the United States attributed to over 19% of the
11 nation’s energy.

13 Section 3: Nuclear energy is 100% carbon free and the radioactive emissions from the power plants are
14 properly taken care off.

15

16 Section 4: Initially, a pilot program will be established to determine the effectiveness and safety of the
17 nuclear power plant, and a determination on whether or not to build more will be determined 5 years after
18 the opening of the first power plant.

19

20 Section 5: This bill will go into effect January 1, 2016, with construction of the power plant taking place no
21 more than 3 years later.
