1 An act to establish a Cold Case Division of the Kentucky Department of Justice under the State Attorney  
2 General's Office.

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5  
6 Section 1: Each year in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, there are \_\_\_ unsolved serious crimes which are  
7 considered "cold cases" once the evidence and leads have reached a dead end. Often, many of these "cold  
8 cases" will remain unattended for many years, never to be solved and the victims and families of the victims  
9 never to see justice.

10  
11 Section 2: In an attempt to centralize these investigations, all existing and future cold cases across the  
12 Commonwealth will be handled by this specialized Cold Case Detective Unit.

13  
14 Section 3: The Cold Case Unit will be staffed by three full-time experienced police detectives with the full  
15 resources of the state crime lab at their disposal.

16  
17 Section 4: This unit will attempt to bring justice to families across the Commonwealth of Kentucky as they  
18 work to solve crimes and remove criminals from the general population.

19  
20 Section 5: This unit will be created and effective January 1, 2016.
