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- 1 An act to remove the tenure system from public schools in the state of Kentucky
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- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: This act will remove the tenure system from public schools throughout Kentucky. Teachers will be
- 6 granted three year employment contracts. Contract renewal and salary will be based on the teacher’s ability
- 7 to meet standards set by each individual school.
- 8
- 9 Section 2: School administration will be required to provide evidence of a teacher’s ability to meet the
- 10 school’s standards in order to renew the contract and increase salary.
- 11
- 12 Section 3: Standards will be based on each school’s particular needs and to improve learning among their
- 13 student population.
- 14
- 15 Section 4: A committee will review each teacher on a yearly basis to evaluate performance and ability to
- 16 meet standards. The review committee will be comprised of administrators from the state, district, and from
- 17 within the school.
- 18
- 19 Section 5: Any school that fails to follow the proposed system will be reviewed by the district and that
- 20 school’s administration will be required to follow the policy.
- 21
- 22 Section 6: This bill will take effect the following school year that it is passed.
