5	Section 1: This act will remove the tenure system from public schools throughout Kentucky. Teachers will be granted three year employment contracts. Contract renewal and salary will be based on the teacher's ability

Section 2: School administration will be required to provide evidence of a teacher's ability to meet the school's standards in order to renew the contract and increase salary.

Section 3: Standards will be based on each school's particular needs and to improve learning among their student population.

Section 4: A committee will review each teacher on a yearly basis to evaluate performance and ability to meet standards. The review committee will be comprised of administrators from the state, district, and from within the school.

Section 5: Any school that fails to follow the proposed system will be reviewed by the district and that school's administration will be required to follow the policy.
