- 1 An act to require all restaurants in the Commonwealth of Kentucky to list a calorie count next to each item
- 2 on their menu.

- 4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 5
- 6 Section 1: All restaurants in the state of Kentucky will be required to list the number of calories for each item
- 7 on their menu.
- 8
- 9 Section 2: This will include: Regular menus, kids menus, drive thru and all specialized needs menus (example
- 10 diabetic or gluten free) , or any other place where a menu is listed.
- 11
- 12 Section 3: The manager of his or her restaurant or corporate office of chain restaurants will be in charge of
- 13 making sure the restaurant has the correct calorie count for all the items on each menu and drive through.
- 14
- 15 Section 4: The Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services will make yearly checks to ensure all
- 16 restaurants are participating in this act.
- 17
- 18 Section 5: Failure to meet the regulations of this act will result in the following: 1st offense- \$500 fine. 2nd
- 19 offense- \$1000 fine. 3rd offense- Restaurant shut down until regulations are met. 4th offense- Restaurant
- 20 will be shut down permanently.

- 22 Section 6: This act will go into effect on March 1st 2015. A notice will be sent by the Kentucky Cabinet for
- 23 Health and Family Services on January 1st 2015, for all managers to have the regulations of the bill met by
- 24 March 1st 2015.
