- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

- 5 Section 1: Currently returning veterans in the state of Kentucky are having immense difficulty in trying to
- 6 find employment upon returning from the theatre of war. The main reason that returning veterans lack the
- 7 skills needed to compete in the work force.
- 8
- 9 Section 2: This bill aims to ensure that all Kentucky veterans returning from war will receive the appropriate
- 10 training needed that will make them competitive job seekers so they can obtain gainful employment. The
- 11 pure motivation of this bill is to reintegrate returning service members into society as productive citizens.

- 13 Section 3: Money for this bill will be funded by a small percentage of lottery, tobacco, and alcohol sales.

- 15 Section 4: This bill will go into effect January 1st, 2015.
