1 An act to require mopeds to have proof of full coverage insurance.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: All people driving a motorized vehicle, including mopeds, will be required to have proof of full

6 coverage insurance.

8 Section 2: A moped is defined as a low-powered, lightweight motorized bicycle.

10 Section 3: If a driver is found to be operating a moped without insurance, he/she will face the following

11 consequences:

12 1st offense: Pay a fine of \$50 and complete 5 hours of community service.

13 2nd offense: Pay a fine of \$100 and complete 10 hours of community service.

14 3rd offense: The authorities will tow away the moped and the driver will be arrested for lack of insurance for

15 one day.

17 Section 4: This bill will go into effect January 1, 2015.
