Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: In order to ensure that all inmates currently and currently on trial for capital offenses in Kentucky will not longer receive the death penalty as a punishment, the death penalty will immediately enter a permanent state of suspension.

Section 2: The bill will be enforced by Kentucky's court systems. The judges nor jury will not longer be able to select the death penalty as a punishment for inmates.

Section 3: The bill will be enforced with no cost, and in return will save Kentucky millions of dollar in court costs due to the tedious appeals process.

Section 4: This bill will be retroactive and go into effect immediately after it is passed.
