- 1 An act to eradicate the death penalty and give inmates life without parole as an alternative sentence in
- 2 Kentucky.

- 4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 5
- 6 Section 1: In order to ensure that all inmates currently and currently on trial for capital offenses in Kentucky
- 7 will not longer receive the death penalty as a punishment, the death penalty will immediately enter a
- 8 permanent state of suspension.
- 9
- 10 Section 2: The bill will be enforced by Kentucky's court systems. The judges nor jury will not longer be able to
- 11 select the death penalty as a punishment for inmates.
- 12
- 13 Section 3: The bill will be enforced with no cost, and in return will save Kentucky millions of dollar in court
- 14 costs due to the tedious appeals process.

- 16 Section 4: This bill will be retroactive and go into effect immediately after it is passed.
