3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5   Section 1: Schools that use plastic fork, knives, and spoons are required to switch to reusable metal forks,  
6   knives, and spoons.

8   Section 2: They will use the money allocated for purchasing plastic ware to buy silverware. They may use the  
9   rest of their plastic ware supply before switching to silver ware.

11   Section 3: This bill will go into effect at the start of the 2015–2016 school year.
