An act to parents responsible for their childrens actions regarding cyberbulling and online actions.

## Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Presently in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, there are no laws that make parents responsible for their child's bullying actions in the court of law. We want to hold parents, as well as the child, responsible for the bullying actions accused to them.

Section 2: I.P.C.B.C, or Irresponsible Parents over Childs Bullying and Cyberbullying, is a new concept that takes parents and holds them criminally liable for their child's actions, as well as punishing the child.

Section 3: For example, if the child harms another using an item under the parents name, the child, as well as the parent, is held responsible.

Section 4: This bill should be put into effect January 1, 2015.
