- 2 graduates to have 22 credits.

- 4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 5
- 6 Section 1: All students in the state of Kentucky will be required to earn 22 credits to graduate from high
- 7 school, even if they have met ACT benchmarks for graduation before having earned 22 credits.
- 8
- 9 Section 2: This bill will be enforced by the Kentucky Department of Education.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: This bill will go into effect at the beginning of the 2015/2016 school year, excluding currently
- 12 enrolled early graduation students.
