- 1           An act to require that all pets riding in the passenger area of motor vehicle be restrained.
- 2
- 3                       **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5   Section 1: In order to decrease the number of accidents as a result of drivers being distracted by pets, this
- 6   bill will required that all pets riding in the passenger area of motor vehicles be restrained. This bill will save
- 7   the lives of many people as well as pets.
- 8
- 9   Section 2: This bill will be enforced by state and local law enforcements officers. This will be enforced in the
- 10 same manner as other traffic violations such as speeding, texting, or reckless driving.
- 11
- 12 Section 3: There will be no additional cost to implement or enforce this law. The only cost involved may be
- 13 to the pet owner for a restraining device. A restraint is defined as any device (not person) that denies the
- 14 pet physical access to the driver.
- 15
- 16 Section 4: Upon passage of this bill, drivers with unrestrained pets riding in the passenger area of their
- 17 vehicle will be subjected to penalties consistent with Kentucky State Distracted Driver Laws.

- 19 Section 5: This law will go into effect on July 1, 2015.
