1	An act to require that all pets riding in the passenger area of motor vehicle be restrained.
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: In order to decrease the number of accidents as a result of drivers being distracted by pets, this
6	bill will required that all pets riding in the passenger area of motor vehicles be restrained. This bill will save
7	the lives of many people as well as pets.
8	
9	Section 2: This bill will be enforced by state and local law enforcements officers. This will be enforced in the
10	same manner as other traffic violations such as speeding, texting, or reckless driving.
11	
12	Section 3: There will be no additional cost to implement or enforce this law. The only cost involved may be
13	to the pet owner for a restraining device. A restraint is defined as any device (not person) that denies the
14	pet physical access to the driver.
15	
16	Section 4: Upon passage of this bill, drivers with unrestrained pets riding in the passenger area of their
17	vehicle will be subjected to penalties consistent with Kentucky State Distracted Driver Laws.
18	
19	Section 5: This law will go into effect on July 1, 2015.
